

CASAC INITIAL TRAINING

Farnham Family Services is an approved OASAS training provider for the delivery of the Credentialed Alcohol and Substance Abuse Counselor 350-hour initial certification program.

The CASAC is intended for individuals who provide or hope to provide direct clinical care services and substance use disorder counseling.

Cost: \$5,250.00 (scholarships and payment plans available)

PEER FOUNDATIONAL TRAINING

This 50-hour course covers the required modules for the NYCB Certified Recovery Peer Advocate (CRPA) credential and includes 4 hours on Medication Supported Recovery, meeting all training and certification requirements.

At the end of this course, participants will be eligible to apply for the provisional CRPA status (CRPA-P) and sit for the NYCB/IC&RC Peer Recovery Exam.

SCREENING, BRIEF INTERVENTION, AND REFERRAL TO TREATMENT

SBIRT (Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment) is an evidence-based method used to identify and address risky substance use. Its goal is to reduce or prevent substance-related harm through early intervention and support. Twelve-hour and four-hour classes available.
